**Administrative and budgetary aspects of the financing of
the United Nations peacekeeping operations: financing
of the United Nations peacekeeping operations**

**Proposed budgetary requirements of each peacekeeping
operation for the period from 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001**

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The budgetary information contained in the annex to the present note is submitted pursuant to section I, paragraph 8, of General Assembly resolution 49/233 A of 23 December 1994, in which the Assembly requested the Secretary-General to submit to the Assembly twice a year, for information purposes, a table summarizing the proposed budgetary requirements of each peacekeeping operation for the period from 1 July to 30 June, including a breakdown of expenditure by major line item and the aggregate total resource requirement.
2. The budgetary information covers the estimated requirements for the period from 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001 of all current peacekeeping operations and has been extracted from the reports of the Secretary-General on the financing of each of the missions.
3. The annex also includes prorated provision for the support account for peacekeeping operations and for the United Nations Logistics Base at Brindisi for the period from 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001, based on the reports of the Secretary-General (A/54/800 and A/54/733), after application of their respective unencumbered balances for the period 1 July 1998 to 30 June 1999.
4. In accordance with resolution 49/233 A, the budgetary information will be updated in the second note for the year, which will be issued during the fifty-fifth session of the General Assembly.
