

## Proposed budgetary requirements of each peacekeeping operation for the period from 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001

## Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. The budgetary information contained in the annex to the present note is submitted pursuant to section I, paragraph 8, of General Assembly resolution 49/233 A of 23 December 1994, in which the Assembly requested the Secretary-General to submit to the Assembly twice a year, for information purposes, a table summarizing the proposed budgetary requirements of each peacekeeping operation for the period from 1 July to 30 June, including a breakdown of expenditure by major line item and the aggregate total resource requirement.
- 2. The budgetary information covers the estimated requirements for the period from 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001 of all current peacekeeping operations and has been extracted from the reports of the Secretary-General on the financing of each of the missions.
- 3. The annex also includes prorated provision for the support account for peacekeeping operations and for the United Nations Logistics Base at Brindisi for the period from 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001, based on the reports of the Secretary-General (A/54/800 and A/54/733), after application of their respective unencumbered balances for the period 1 July 1998 to 30 June 1999.
- 4. In accordance with resolution 49/233 A, the budgetary information will be updated in the second note for the year, which will be issued during the fifty-fifth session of the General Assembly.
