**The situation in Central America: procedures for the establishment of a firm and lasting peace and progress in fashioning a region of peace, freedom, democracy and development: United Nations Verification Mission in Guatemala: programme budget implications of draft resolution A/57/L.27/Rev.1**

The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General<sup>1</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup> decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/57/L.27/Rev.1, additional appropriations would be required for the programme budget for 2002-2003 in an amount of \$11,631,400 under section 3, Political affairs, and an amount of \$1,359,000 under section 32, Staff assessment, offset by an amount of \$1,359,000, under income section 1, Income from staff assessment.

The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General<sup>3</sup> and the related report of the

Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>4</sup> decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/57/L.20, additional appropriations would be required for the programme budget for 2002-2003 in an amount of \$182,900 under section 3, Political affairs, and an amount of \$41,400 under section 32, Staff assessment, offset by an amount of \$41,400 under income section 1, Income from staff assessment.

**Situation of human rights in Myanmar: programme budget implications of draft resolution A/C.3/57/L.48**

The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General<sup>5</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>6</sup> decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/C.3/57/L.48, additional appropriations would be required for the programme budget for 2002-2003 in an amount of \$163,900 under section 3, Political affairs, and an amount of \$65,200 under section 32, Staff assessment, offset by an amount of \$65,200 under income section 1, Income from staff assessment.
