### Report of the Secretary-General on the activities of the Office of Internal Oversight Services

**Draft resolution submitted by the Chairman following informal consultations**

### **Management review of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights**

*The General Assembly,*

*Recalling* its resolutions 48/218 B of 29 July 1994 and 54/244 of 23 December 1999, and all its other relevant resolutions,

*Recalling also* its resolutions 56/253 of 24 December 2001 and 57/300 of 20 December 2002,

*Recalling further* its decision 55/488 of 7 September 2001,

*Having considered* the report of the Office of Internal Oversight Services on the management review of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights,<sup>1</sup>

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Office of Internal Oversight Services on the management review of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights;<sup>1</sup>

2. *Requests* the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its fifty-eighth session on measures pertaining to the administration and management of the Office of the High Commissioner, taking into account the report of the Office of Internal Oversight Services,<sup>1</sup> as appropriate, and the report of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights requested by the Secretary-General, as indicated in action 5 of his report entitled “Strengthening of the United Nations: an agenda for further change”;<sup>2</sup>

3. *Decides* to revert at its fifty-eighth session to the issue of the administration and management of the Office of the High Commissioner, in the context of its consideration of the proposed programme budget for 2004-2005, as well as to the issues relevant to the functioning of the Office addressed in its resolution 57/300, in particular paragraphs 6, 8, 9 and 10, in the context of the procedures it establishes for consideration of the progress report of the Secretary-General on the implementation of the reform measures considered in that resolution.
