Draft resolution submitted by the Chairman following informal consultations

Human resources management

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolutions 59/266 of 23 December 2004, 61/244 of 22 December 2006, section VIII of its resolution 61/276 of 29 June 2007 and section XXI of its resolution 62/238 of 22 December 2007, as well as its other relevant resolutions and decisions,

Having considered the reports of the Secretary-General on the staffing of field missions, including the use of 300- and 100-series appointments,¹ on detailed proposals for streamlining United Nations contractual arrangements² and on harmonization of conditions of service,³ the addendum to the report of the International Civil Service Commission for 2006⁴ and section II of the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,⁵

1. *Takes note* of the reports of the Secretary-General on the staffing of field missions, including the use of 300- and 100-series appointments,¹ on detailed proposals for streamlining United Nations contractual arrangements,² and on harmonization of conditions of service;³

2. *Decides* to continue consideration of the issue of contractual arrangements and conditions of service, including in United Nations field operations, as a matter of priority at the main part of its sixty-third session, taking into account the conclusions and recommendations contained in section II of the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,⁵ with a view to the implementation of the new arrangements and conditions on 1 July 2009.
