#### Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments

## Confirmation of the appointment of members of the Investments Committee

### Note by the Secretary-General

1. As indicated in document A/63/103 of 19 March 2008, it will be necessary for the General Assembly, during its current session, to confirm the appointment by the Secretary-General of three persons to fill vacancies in the Investments Committee resulting from the expiration, on 31 December 2008, of the terms of office of Masakazu Arikawa (Japan), Madhav Dhar (India) and Nemir A. Kirdar (Iraq); an ad hoc member, Ivan Pictet (Switzerland); and two persons to fill vacancies resulting from the resignations in July 2007 of Khaya Ngqula (South Africa) and Afsaneh Beschloss (Islamic Republic of Iran).

2. In accordance with the provisions of article 20 of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, the Secretary General, after consultation with the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, submits for confirmation by the General Assembly the reappointment of Mr. Arikawa, Mr. Dhar and Mr. Kirdar as regular members for three-year terms of office and Mr. Pictet as an ad hoc member for a one-year term beginning on 1 January 2009. Mr. Arikawa is the President and Representative Director of Mcube Investment Solutions in Japan and has served on the Investments Committee since 2005. Mr. Dhar is the Managing Partner of Traxis Partners, LLC, and has served on the Committee since 2006. Mr. Kirdar is the Founder, Executive Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Investcorp in New York, London and Bahrain and has served on the Committee since 2006. Mr. Pictet is the Senior Managing Partner of Pictet & Cie in Switzerland and has served on the Committee as an ad hoc member since 2005.

3. The Secretary-General, after consultations with the Pension Board and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, submits for confirmation by the General Assembly the appointment of Linah K. Mohohlo (Botswana), Governor of the Bank of Botswana, as a regular member to replace



Mr. Ngqula; and Mr. Simon Jiang (China), Founder and Chairman of CyberCity International Limited and Chairman of Vision Century Corporation, as an ad hoc member to replace Ms. Beschloss commencing 1 January 2009.
