Bolivia (Plurinational State of):* draft resolution

First performance report on the programme budget for the biennium 2014-2015

The General Assembly,

Having considered the first performance report of the Secretary-General on the programme budget for the biennium 2014-2015¹ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,²

1. *Reaffirms* the budgetary process as approved in its resolutions 41/213 of 19 December 1986, and 42/211 of 21 December 1987 and reaffirmed in subsequent resolutions;

2. *Takes note* of the first performance report of the Secretary-General;¹

3. *Endorses* the conclusions and recommendations contained in the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,² subject to the provisions of the present resolution;

4. Urges the Secretary-General to ensure that oral statements detailing resource requirements are presented to the General Assembly in a timely manner before the adoption of substantive resolutions in accordance with rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the Assembly and to provide information on the full scope of additional resources needed;

5. *Approves* a net increase of ______ United States dollars in the appropriation approved for the biennium 2014-2015 and a net increase of ______ dollars in the estimates of income for the biennium, to be apportioned among expenditure and income sections as indicated in the first performance report of the Secretary-General;
