Note by the Secretary-General

1. Pursuant to section I, paragraph 8, of General Assembly resolution [49/233 A](#), the present note reflects the approved resources for peacekeeping operations, the United Nations Logistics Base at Brindisi, Italy, the Regional Service Centre in Entebbe, Uganda, and the support account for peacekeeping operations for the period from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020 (see annex).
