

Programme budget implications of draft decision A/76/L.46

The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General 1 and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, 2 decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft decision A/76/L.46, additional resources amounting to 1,003,000 United States dollars would be required for 2022, comprising 894,700 dollars under section 2, General Assembly and Economic and Social Council affairs and conference management, 58,100 dollars under section 28, Global communications, 27,200 dollars under section 29C, Office of Information and Communications Technology, and 23,000 dollars under section 34, Safety and security, of the programme budget for 2022, together with an amount of 107,400 dollars under section 36, Staff assessment, to be offset by an equivalent amount under income section 1, Income from staff assessment.
