The meeting was called to order at 11.45 a.m.

## Agenda item 5: Election of the officers of the Main Committees

1. **The Chair** said that, in accordance with rule 99 (a) of the rules of procedure, the meeting had been convened for the purpose of electing the Chair and other members of the Bureau of the Committee for the seventy-seventh session of the General Assembly.

2. The nomination of Mr. Alfonso (Mozambique) for the post of Chair had been endorsed by the Group of African States. In the absence of further nominations, and in accordance with rule 103 of the rules of procedure, she would take it that the Committee wished to elect Mr. Alfonso (Mozambique) Chair.

3. Mr. Alfonso (Mozambique) was elected Chair by acclamation.

4. **Mr. Alfonso** (Mozambique) said that his country would contribute to promoting and upholding the rulesbased order, because international law was key to multilateralism and a world of peace.

5. **The Chair** said that the nominations of Mr. Matta (Guatemala), Mr. Romanzka (Bulgaria) and Ms. Sverrisdóttir (Iceland) had been endorsed by the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States, the Group of Eastern European States and the Group of Western European and Other States, respectively, for the three posts of Vice-Chair, and that the nomination of Ms. Ruhama (Malaysia) for the post of Rapporteur had been endorsed by the Group of Asia-Pacific States.

6. Mr. Matta (Guatemala), Mr. Romanzka (Bulgaria) and Ms. Sverrisdóttir (Iceland) were elected Vice-Chairs, and Ms. Ruhama (Malaysia) was elected Rapporteur, by acclamation.
