The Government of India recognizes the People's Republic of Kampuchea as the sole and legitimate Government of Kampuchea. In our view, it is that Government which should have been appropriately enabled to participate in this Conference. Our participation is without prejudice to our well-known position.

I would request that this letter be circulated to all participants as a document of this Conference.
