FINAL ACT OF THE ELEVENTH UNITED NATIONS PLEDGING CONFERENCE
FOR THE UNITED NATIONS DISARMAMENT INFORMATION PROGRAMME

1. Pursuant to paragraph 8 of General Assembly resolution 47/53 D of 9 December 1992, in which the Assembly decided that at its forty-eighth session there should be an eleventh United Nations pledging conference for the United Nations Disarmament Information Programme, and expressed "the hope that on that occasion all those Member States that have not yet announced any voluntary contributions will do so", the Secretary-General, by a note verbale dated 19 August 1993, informed Member States that he intended to convene, on 29 October 1993 at United Nations Headquarters, a pledging conference for that purpose.
2. The Conference met at United Nations Headquarters on 29 October 1993. It was attended by representatives of the Governments of the following States: Algeria, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belarus, Botswana, Brazil, Brunei Darussalam, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cyprus, Egypt, Ethiopia, Finland, France, Gabon, Germany, Greece, Indonesia, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Italy, Japan, Kuwait, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Malaysia, Mexico, Nepal, Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea, Sierra Leone, Spain, Sri Lanka, Sweden, Thailand, Togo, Ukraine and Venezuela.
3. The Conference heard the announcement of pledges by a number of Governments contributing to the Voluntary Trust Fund for the United Nations Disarmament Information Programme as well as other statements regarding pledges.
4. In accordance with rule 21 of the rules of procedure of the Conference, the Secretary-General shall maintain, for a specified period (until 31 March 1994), a list of pledges made or announced at the Conference; States invited to the Conference may enter on that list pledges in addition to those made or announced at the Conference. At the end of that period, the Secretary-General shall issue that list as part of the records of the Conference (A/CONF.170/2).

5. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the President of the Conference and the Secretary-General of the United Nations have signed the Final Act.

DONE at the United Nations, New York, this twenty-ninth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and ninety-three, in a single copy in the Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish languages, the six texts being equally authentic. The original text shall be deposited with the Secretary-General.
