REPORT OF THE 1994 UNITED NATIONS PLEDGING CONFERENCE FOR DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

1. By its resolution 45/215 of 21 December 1990, the General Assembly decided, <u>inter alia</u>, that the adoption and signing of the Final Act of the Conference should be replaced by the adoption of a procedural report of the Conference.

A. Opening and duration of the Conference

2. The Conference was held at United Nations Headquarters on 1 and 2 November 1994.

3. The Conference was opened, on behalf of the Secretary-General, by Mr. Ismat Kittani, Under-Secretary-General and Special Adviser to the Secretary-General.

B. <u>Attendance</u>

4. The Conference was attended by representatives of the Governments of the following States:

E. <u>Announcement of pledges</u>

It took note of the fact that several Governments were not in a position to announce their contributions, but proposed to communicate their announcement of such contributions to the Secretary-General as soon as they were in a position to do so after the closure of the Conference.

9. The Conference heard concluding statements by the Administrator of the United Nations Development Programme, the Executive Director of the United Nations Children's Fund and the Executive Director of the United Nations Population Fund.
