- 1. In the Final Act of the Thirteenth United Nations Pledging Conference for the United Nations Disarmament Information Programme (A/CONF.179/2), the Secretary-General was requested to maintain a list incorporating pledges made or announced at the Conference and those made thereafter and to issue that list as part of the records of the Conference.
- 2. The present document is issued pursuant to that request.
- 3. In the following list, pledges are for the United Nations Disarmament Information Programme unless otherwise specified. Each pledge is shown first in the currency in which it was made and, when this was not the United States dollar, it is also shown in United States dollars.
