**Annex to the letter dated 28 July 2015 from the Permanent Representative of Malawi to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General of the Conference**

**Explanation of position**

While Malawi accepts the adoption of the Addis Ababa Action Agenda, Malawi would like to register its strong reservation on paragraph 32 of the outcome document of the third International Conference on Financing for Development. The paragraph does not take into account the consequences for tobacco-producing countries such as Malawi, whose economies substantially depend on tobacco production.

In respect of tobacco-producing countries, we would have preferred that paragraph 32 end as follows:

“In order not to leave anyone behind, countries whose economies substantially depend on tobacco production must be supported and compensated for the loss of revenue within the framework of the United Nations and other international aid agencies as they diversify out of tobacco.”
