The meeting was called to order at 3.15 p.m.

GENERAL EXCHANGE OF VIEWS (continued)

1. <u>Mr. AL NUQARI</u> (Observer for the Syrian Arab Republic), referring to the statement made by the representative of Human Rights Watch at the previous meeting, said that it hardly seemed appropriate to congratulate Israel on its moratorium on exports of anti-personnel mines, given the number of casualties caused by Israeli actions in the region.

2. <u>The PRESIDENT</u> noted that no subsidiary bodies had been established.

CONSIDERATION AND ADOPTION OF THE FINAL DOCUMENT

(CCW/AP.II/CONF.10/CRP.1; non-paper containing amendments to the preceding document, circulated in the meeting room in English only)

3. <u>The PRESIDENT</u> drew attention to the draft final document of the Tenth Annual Conference of the High Contracting Parties to Amended Protocol II (CCW/AP.II/CONF.10/CRP.1) and to the non-paper containing amendments thereto, and invited the Conference to consider the draft final document paragraph by paragraph prior to adopting the text as a whole.

Paragraphs 1 to 3

4. <u>Paragraphs 1 to 3 were adopted</u>.

Paragraph 4

5. <u>The PRESIDENT</u> said that the first sentence should read: "The Conference held two plenary meetings." The third sentence should read: "It also confirmed the nominations of Ambassador Cheng Jingye of China, Mr. Valery Semin of the Russian Federation, and Mr. Johann Kellerman of South Africa as Vice-Presidents."

6. Paragraph 4, as amended, was adopted.

8. <u>Mr. NJAKO</u> (Cameroon) and <u>Ms. BAQUERIZO GUZMÁN</u> (Ecuador) said that the names of their countries should be added to the list of States parties that had notified the Depositary of their consent to be bound by amended Protocol II and had participated in the work of the Conference.

13. <u>The PRESIDENT</u> said that the paragraph should be amended to read: "At the same meeting the Conference received a message from the Secretary-General of the United Nations, which was delivered by Mr. Tim Caughley, Deputy Secretary-General of the Conference on Disarmament and Director of the United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs, Geneva Branch."

15. <u>The PRESIDENT</u> drew attention to the list of States and representatives of organizations that had participated in the discussions under agenda items 8 to 10, which should be added to the paragraph.

18. <u>Ms. SANCAR</u> (Turkey) said that Turkey should be added to the list of States that had submitted national annual reports.

21. <u>The PRESIDENT</u> announced that, following consultations among the regional groups, it had been decided to nominate Ambassador Jānis Mažeiks of Latvia as President of the

Eleventh Annual Conference and representatives of China, Senegal and a member of the Group of Western European and Other States as Vice-Presidents. If he heard no objection, he would take it that the conference wished to accept those nominations and to amend the paragraph accordingly.

28. <u>Mr. HODSON</u> (United States of America) said that his preference would have been for a one-day session. He hoped, nevertheless, that the two-day session would be productive.
