1. In Part II, Final Declaration, <u>amend</u> preambular paragraph 1 to read:

Recalling the preceding Declarations adopted by the First Review Conference in 1996 and the Second Review Conference in 2001, in particular preambular paragraphs 3, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 12, as well as operative paragraphs 2, 3, 8, 12, and 14 to 16 of the Final Declaration of the Second Review Conference.

2. In Part II, Final Declaration, <u>insert</u> a new preambular paragraph 9bis<sup>1</sup> to read:

Recognising the crucial role of the International Committee of the Red Cross and encouraging it to continue to work to facilitate further ratifications and accessions to the Convention and its annexed Protocols, to disseminate their contents and to lend its expertise to future Conferences and other meetings related to the Convention and its annexed Protocols.
