LETTER DATED 28 JUNE 2006 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF MEXICO ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE CONFERENCE ON DISARMAMENT INFORMING HIM THAT ON 19 JUNE 2006 THE GOVERNMENT OF EL SALVADOR DEPOSITED WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF MEXICO, IN ITS CAPACITY AS DEPOSITARY OF THE TREATY OF TLATELOLCO, ITS INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION OF THE AMENDMENTS TO THE TREATY FOR THE PROHIBITION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN (TREATY OF TLATELOLCO)

I have pleasure in informing you that, on 19 June 2006, the Government of the Republic of El Salvador deposited with my Government, in its capacity as depositary of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean (Treaty of Tlatelolco), its instrument of ratification of the amendments referred to in OPANAL resolution 290 (E-VII) of 26 August 1992.

I should be very grateful if you would take the necessary steps for the present communication to be published and circulated as an official document of the Conference on Disarmament.
