Extensions of country programmes Note of the Administrator

Summary

The present note contains information on the extensions of the country programmes for Burkina Faso, Chad, Côte d'Ivoire, Lebanon, Libya, and Somalia. Requests for first one-year extensions of country programmes are approved by the Administrator and presented to the Executive Board for information. Requests for second one-year extensions, two-year extensions and exceptional extensions of country programmes are submitted to the Executive Board for approval.

Elements of a decision

The Executive Board may wish to take note of the first one-year extensions of the country programmes for Burkina Faso, Chad and Somalia from 1 January to 31 December 2016. The Executive Board may wish to approve the exceptional one-year extension of the country programme for Côte d'Ivoire from 1 January to 31 December 2016, and the second one-year extensions of the country programmes for Lebanon and Libya from 1 January to 31 December 2016.
