# **Extensions of country programmes**

### Note of the Administrator

#### Summary

The present note contains information on the extensions of the country programmes for Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cape Verde, Central African Republic, Gabon, Mauritania, Senegal and Yemen. Requests for first one-year extensions of country programmes are approved by the Administrator and presented to the Executive Board for information. Requests for second one-year extensions, two-year extensions and exceptional extensions of country programmes are submitted to the Board for approval.

#### Elements of a decision

The Executive Board may wish to take note of the first one-year extensions of the country programmes for Burundi, Cape Verde, Central African Republic, Gabon and Mauritania from 1 January to 31 December 2017.

The Executive Board may wish to approve the second one-year extensions of the country programmes for Burkina Faso and Yemen from 1 January to 31 December 2017, and the two-year extension of the country programme for Senegal from 1 January 2017 to 31 December 2018.
