Summary

The present note contains information on the extensions of the country programmes for Madagascar and Yemen. Requests for first one-year extensions of country programmes are approved by the Administrator and presented to the Executive Board for information. Requests for second one-year extensions, two-year extensions and exceptional extensions of country programmes are submitted to the Board for approval.

Elements of a decision

The Executive Board may wish to: (a) take note of the first one-year extension of the country programme for Madagascar from 1 January to 31 December 2020; and (b) approve the fourth extension of the country programme for Yemen for one year, from 1 January to 31 December 2020.
