# Nomination of 20 members of the Committee for Programme and Coordination

#### Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. In accordance with Economic and Social Council resolution 2008 (LX) and General Assembly decision 42/450, the Council is to nominate 20 members for election by the Assembly at its sixty-ninth session to fill the vacancies in the Committee for Programme and Coordination that will occur on 31 December 2014 upon the expiration of the terms of the following members: Argentina, Belarus, Brazil, Bulgaria, Cameroon, Cuba, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Italy, Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Pakistan, Republic of Moldova, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Uruguay and Zimbabwe, as well as two members from Western European and other States whose seats remain vacant. The term of office is three years, beginning on 1 January 2015.
- 2. The Council is reminded that the General Assembly, in section III of its resolution 3392 (XXX) on the review of the intergovernmental and expert machinery dealing with the formulation, review and approval of programmes and budgets, encouraged Member States to be represented in the Committee for Programme and Coordination at an adequate level in order to raise the expertise of the Committee.
- 3. The vacancies are to be filled according to the following pattern:

Four members from African States:

Four members from Asia-Pacific States;

Three members from Eastern European States;

Four members from Latin American and Caribbean States;

Five members from Western European and other States (includes two unfilled vacancies).

4. The membership of the Committee in 2014 is given in the annex to the present note.
