## Election of 13 members of the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting

## Note by the Secretary-General

1. Under the terms of its resolutions $1982 / 67$ and $1985 / 71$, the Economic and Social Council is to elect 13 members of the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting, for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2016, to fill the vacancies that will occur on 31 December 2015 upon the expiration of the terms of the following members: Brazil, Cameroon, Ghana, Libya and Mauritius. In addition, the four seats from Asia-Pacific States, the two seats from Eastern European States and the two seats from Latin American and Caribbean States that remain vacant are to be filled.
2. The election will be held at the coordination and management meetings of the Council, from 8 to 10 April 2015.
3. The members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
(a) Four members from African States;
(b) Four members from Asia-Pacific States (all vacant seats);
(c) Two members from Eastern European States (all vacant seats);
(d) Three members from Latin American and Caribbean States (includes two unfilled vacancies).
4. The membership of the Working Group in 2015 is listed in the annex to the present note.
