Draft decision E/2022/L.3: Procedure for taking decisions of the sessional bodies and the subsidiary organs of the Economic and Social Council during the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic at the 2022 session of the Council

- 1. The President said that the draft decision had no programme budget implications. The President of the Council had submitted the draft decision after consultations with the Bureau. In circulating it to Member States, he had indicated that he would follow guidance provided by the President of the General Assembly and the Secretary-General. The intent of the draft decision was not to discourage subsidiary bodies from meeting in person, but rather to provide a decision-making modality for those subsidiary bodies for which it was not practicable to meet in person. She took it that the Council wished to adopt the draft decision.
- 2. It was so decided.

Organizational Committee of the Peacebuilding Commission

- 3. **The President** said that the candidature of Portugal had been endorsed by the Group of Western European and other States to complete the unexpired portion of the term of Norway, from 16 February 2022 to 31 December 2022.
- 4. She took it that the Council wished to elect Portugal by acclamation to the Organizational Committee of the Peacebuilding Commission for a term beginning on 16 February 2022 and expiring on 31 December 2022.
- 5. It was so decided.

Draft decision E/2022/L.2: Appointment of an additional member of the Ad Hoc Advisory Group on Haiti

- 8. **Mr. Black** (Canada), speaking on behalf of his country in its capacity as Chair of the Ad Hoc Advisory Group on Haiti, said that the addition of Saint Vincent and the Grenadine to the Group would enrich the quality of its work and help it to provide useful insights and advice to support the socioeconomic development of Haiti.

Draft resolution E/2022/L.4: Revised terms of reference of the Inland Transport Committee of the Economic Commission for Europe

- 9. Draft resolution E/2022/L.4 was adopted.
- 10. Mr. Mack (United States of America) said that his country had joined the consensus on the revised terms of reference of the Inland Transport Committee of the Economic Commission for Europe. However, it urged that Committee to take additional steps to ensure that the Economic Commission for Europe did not simply promote one set of regional regulations and agreements over other relevant ones. Specifically, the Inland Transport Committee should take additional steps to ensure the Economic Commission for Europe did not simply promote European practices worldwide.
- 11. The Working Party on Automated/Autonomous and Connected Vehicles of the World Forum for the Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations was a good example of a global approach. Delegates from Europe, Asia and North America shared equal responsibility for the activities and outcomes of the Group, and documents were prepared in a manner that was neutral with respect to other relevant regulations and agreements.
