## I. Organization of the session

1. The Committee for Programme and Coordination held its organizational session (1st meeting) on 24 April 2014 and its substantive session from 2 to 27 June 2014 at United Nations Headquarters. It held a total of 22 meetings and numerous informal consultations.

### A. Agenda

2. The agenda for the fifty-fourth session, adopted by the Committee at its 1st meeting, is contained in annex I to the present report.

### Selection of reports of the Joint Inspection Unit

3. At the same meeting, the attention of the Committee was drawn to the note by the Secretariat ([E/AC.51/2014/L.2](#)) submitted pursuant to Economic and Social Council resolution 2008 (LX) and General Assembly resolution [59/267](#), containing the information that there were no relevant reports of the Joint Inspection Unit available for consideration by the Committee at the present session.

### Programme of work
