Note by the Secretary-General

Pursuant to the Regulations and Rules Governing Programme Planning, the Programme Aspects of the Budget, the Monitoring of Implementation and the Methods of Evaluation (ST/SGB/2000/8), the Commission on Narcotic Drugs and the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice are invited to review the proposed biennial programme plan for programme 13, International drug control, crime and terrorism prevention and criminal justice (A/69/6 (Prog. 13)), and provide their comments to the Secretary-General.
