

Changes in the scope of control of substances: proposed scheduling recommendations by the World Health Organization on cannabis and cannabis-related substances

The Commission on Narcotic Drugs decides to postpone the voting on the recommendations of the World Health Organization regarding the critical review of cannabis and cannabis-related substances, which were transmitted to the Secretary-General after the three-month period established pursuant to Commission resolution 2 (S-VII) of 8 February 1982, entitled "Procedure to be followed by the Commission on Narcotic Drugs in matters of scheduling of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances", in order to provide States with more time to consider the recommendations.
