UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE ON INTERNATIONAL COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION

CONSIDERATION OF THE DRAFT CONVENTION ON THE REJOGNITION AND ENFORCEMENT OF FOREIGN ARBITICAL AWARDS (ITEM 4 OF THE AGENDA)

Text of Article I, paragraph 2, of the Convention as a lopted by the Conference at its 21st meeting

2. Any State may, on the basis of reciprocity, when signing, ratifying or acceding to this Convention, or notifying extension under Article IX hereof, declare that it will apply the Convention only to the recognition and enforcement of awards made in the territory of another Contracting State.

The Conference also decided that the Convention should contain a provision stimulating that no further reservations shall be permissible, and left it to the Drafting Committee to prepare a text of this provision.
