The report provides an overview of the development effectiveness of UNICEF based on evidence from evaluations completed from 2012 to 2015. Analysis of the findings from previous evaluations enabled the systematic assessment of performance in achieving development results over recent years. The evidence base was also examined for coverage and quality. While reaching broadly positive conclusions, the review identified several areas in which UNICEF needs to further strengthen its performance and provides a set of recommendations intended to support improvements.
