Background

- 1. The United Nations Centre for Trade Facilitation and Electronic Business (UN/CEFACT) held its twenty-eighth Plenary session in Geneva on 10 and 11 October 2022. The report of the session is contained in the document ECE/TRADE/C/CEFACT/2022/2.
- 2. UN/CEFACT Plenary adopted the UN/CEFACT Programme of Work for 2023–2024 and decided to extend until 2025 the mandate of the Team of Specialists on Environmental, Social and Governance Traceability of Sustainable Value Chains in the Circular Economy.
- 3. The Executive Committee is invited to approve the above decisions.
