Letter dated 30 January 2007 from the Chairman of the Peacebuilding Commission to the members of the Organizational Committee

The Chairman of the Peacebuilding Commission established pursuant to General Assembly resolution 60/180 and Security Council resolution 1645 (2005) presents his compliments to the members of the Organizational Committee of the Commission and has the honour to transmit herewith, for their consideration, a letter dated 19 January from the Permanent Representative of the United Republic of Tanzania, requesting that the United Republic of Tanzania continue its membership in the country-specific configuration on Burundi (see annex). You will recall that the membership of the United Republic of Tanzania in the Organizational Committee — and thereby also in the country-specific configurations — expired with its membership in the Security Council on 31 December 2006.

The Chairman wishes to advise that unless he hears to the contrary by 5 p.m. on Friday, 2 February 2007, he will take it that the members of the Organizational Committee have no objection to the request contained in the above-mentioned letter. Should the Committee have no objection, the United Republic of Tanzania will be invited to participate in the joint country-specific meeting to be held on 5 February 2007.

**Letter dated 19 January 2007 from the Permanent Representative
of the United Republic of Tanzania to the United Nations
addressed to the Chairman of the Peacebuilding Commission**

The membership of the United Republic of Tanzania in the Security Council came to an end on 31 December 2006. As you know, our membership in the Organizational Committee of the Peacebuilding Commission also expired with our membership in the Council.

In view of Tanzania's continuing interest as a neighbour in the peacebuilding phase in Burundi, particularly with respect to the repatriation of refugees, it would like to remain a member of the country-specific configuration on Burundi of the Peacebuilding Commission.
