Request by Croatia for membership in the Burundi configuration

Note by the Chairperson of the Commission

The Chairperson of the Peacebuilding Commission established pursuant to General Assembly resolution 60/180 and Security Council resolution 1645 (2005) has the honour to transmit to the Organizational Committee a letter dated 21 June 2007 from the Permanent Representative of Croatia to the United Nations containing a request that Croatia become a member of the Commission's Burundi configuration, pursuant to paragraph 7 (b) of the aforementioned resolutions (see annex).

The Chairperson wishes to advise that unless he receives indication to the contrary by 5 p.m. on Tuesday 24 July 2007, he will take it that the members of the Organizational Committee have no objection to the request contained in the above-mentioned letter. Should the Committee have no objection, Croatia will be invited to participate in the Commission's upcoming meetings of the Burundi configuration under paragraph 7 (b) of General Assembly resolution 60/180 and Security Council resolution 1645 (2005).
