LETTER DATED 28 FEBRUARY 1973 FROM THE ACTING PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVES OF PANAMA AND PERU TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

The undersigned members of the Security Council hereby request that, at its meetings in Panama City devoted to "Consideration of measures for the maintenance and strengthening of international peace and security in Latin America in conformity with the provisions and principles of the Charter", the Security Council should extend invitations, under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, to Mr. Héctor Gros Espiell, Secretary-General of the Agency for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America, and to those members of the secretariat of the Agency, who accompany him.
