NOTE VERBALE DATED 25 NOVEMBER 1977 FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF THE SEYCHELLES ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Minister of Foreign Affairs and Tourism of the Republic of Seychelles presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the Secretary-General's Note No. PO 230 SOAF of 10 November 1977, concerning Security Council resolution 418 (1977) of 4 November 1977.

The Secretary-General may wish to report to the Security Council that:

- (a) Seychelles whole-heartedly supports and will comply fully with the provisions of resolution 418 (1977);
- (b) There is no manufacture of arms or military equipment and materials of any kind in Seychelles and so no export or licensing arrangements for such can take place;
- (c) Every effort is being and will continue to be made to ensure that transhipment facilities in Seychelles are not used in an attempt to contravene the provisions of resolution 418 (1977).
