LETTER DATED 8 AUGUST 1983 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE LIBYAN ARAB JAMAHIRIYA TO
THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to my letter of 6 August 1983, circulated as document S/15912, I have the honour to draw attention once more to the intensification of United States intervention in the affairs of the regions of the Mediterranean, the Middle East and Africa and to the acts of intimidation and provocation directed against the Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, which is a part of these regions, as well as to the consequences of the dispatch of United States forces and military equipment to the said regions.

As these acts represent a threat and a danger to the peace and security of these regions and of the world, I request, by order of my country's competent authorities, that the Security Council should meet as a matter of urgency to consider the situation and should put an end to the acts of provocation and hostility perpetrated by the United States, inter alia against the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya.

I should be grateful if you would have the text of this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
