LETTER DATED 21 MAY 1984 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVES OF BAHRAIN, KUWAIT, OMAN, QATAR, SAUDI ARABIA AND THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon instructions from our Governments, we have the honour to request an urgent meeting of the Security Council to consider the Iranian aggressions on the freedom of navigation to and from the ports of our countries. Such aggressions constitute a threat to the stability and security of the area and have serious implications to international peace and security.
