LETTER DATED 2 OCTOBER 1985 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF ARGENTINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to write in connection with the request for the convening of an urgent meeting of the Security Council as a result of the situation created by the Israeli aggression against a civilian settlement situated south of the Tunisian capital. In that connection, I should like to transmit herewith the text of a press release issued on 1 October 1985 by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Worship:

"The Argentine Government condemns the military action taken against the Palestinian camps situated south of the Tunisian capital in violation of Tunisia's sovereignty and territorial integrity.

"The Argentine Government once again affirms that solutions to international problems must be sought through dialogue and negotiation and not through the use of force in violation of the Charter of the United Nations."

I request that this note be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
