At its 2687th mreting, held on 29 May 1986, thr Security Council resumed its consideration of the item, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force (UNDOF) for the period 14 November 1985 to 14 May 1986 (\$/18061).

The President drew attention to the draft resolution before the Council (S/19109), which had been prepared in the course of the Council's consultations.

The Security Council then vottd on the draft resolution (\$/18109) and adopted it unanimously as resolution 584 (1986).

Resolution 584 (1966) reads as follows:

## The Security Council,

Having considered the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force (8/18061).

## Decides:

- (a) To call upon the parties concerned to implement immediately Security Council resolution 336 (1973) of 22 October 1973;
- (b) To renew the mandate of the United Nationr Disengagement Obmerver Force for another period of six months, that is, until 30 November 1986;
- (c) To requert the Secretary-General to submit, at the end of thim period, a report on the developments in the aiturtion and the measures taken to implement Security Council resolution 338 (1973).

Following the voting, the President of the Security Council mtrted that, in connection with the resolution just adopted on the renewal of the mandate of the United Nations Discongagement Observer Force, he had been authorized to make the following complementary statement (\$/18111) on behalf of the Security Council:

"As is known, the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force (S/16061) states, in paragraph 25: 'Despi ta the present quiet in the Israel-Syria sector, the situation in the Middle East as a whole cont inues to be potentially dangerous and is likely to remain so, unless and until a comprehensive settlement covering all aspects of the Middle East problem can he reached,' That statement of the Secetary-General ref lectre the view of the Security Council."
