Congo, Ghana, Madagascar, Trinidad and Tobago and United Arab Emiratesr revised draft resolution

The Security Council,

Having heard the statements made by the representatives of the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya and the United States of America,

<u>Strongly alarmed</u> at the danger to international **peace** and security created by the armed attacks against the Libyan cities **of** Tripoli and Benghazi by the armed forces of the United States of America,

Recalling General Assembly resolution 40/61 Of 9 December 1985, by which the Assembly unequivocally condemned as criminal, all acts, methods and practices of terrorism wherever and by whomever committed, including those which jeapardize friendly relations among states and their security,

Recalling also the Declaration on Principles of International Law concerning Friendly Relations and Co-operation among States in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations, 1/the Declaration on the Strengthening Of International Security 2/ and the Definition of Aggression, 3/

- 1. <u>Condemns</u> the armed **attack** by the United States of America in violation of the Charter of the United Nations and the norms of international conduct;
- 2. <u>Calls upon</u> the united States of America to refrain forthwith from any attacks or threats thereof;
- 3. Condemns all terrorist activities whether perpetrated by individuals, groups or States;

- 4. Calls upon all parties to refrain from resorting to force, to exercise restraint in this critical situation and to resolve their differences by peaceful means in keeping with the Charter of the United Nations;
- 5. Requests the Secretary-General to take all appropriate steps to restore and ensure peace in the Central Mediterranean and to keep the Security Council regularly informed of the implementation of the present resolution;
 - 6. <u>Decides</u> to remain seized of this matter.
