SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3667th meeting, held on 28 May 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the seventeenth progress report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Observer Mission in Liberia (S/1996/362).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Algeria, Djibouti, Ghana, Liberia, Nigeria, Zambia and Zimbabwe, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The Security Council continued its consideration of the item at its 3671st meeting, held on 31 May 1996.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/394) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/394 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1059 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1059 (1996); to be issued in <u>Official Records of the Security Council</u>, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3669th meeting, held on 30 May 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force (UNDOF) for the period from 18 November 1995 to 17 May 1996 (S/1996/368).

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/393) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/393 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1057 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1057 (1996); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).

The President stated that, in connection with the resolution just adopted, he had been authorized to make a complementary statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1996/27; to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3670th meeting, held on 30 May 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General pursuant to Security Council resolution $1046 \ (1996) \ (S/1996/373 \ and Add.1)$.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/392), which had been submitted by France, Germany, Italy, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America, subsequently joined by Poland.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/392, which received 14 votes in favour and none against, with one abstention (Russian Federation) and was adopted as resolution 1058 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1058 (1996); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).
