LETTER DATED 31 MARCH 1998 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1159 (1998) of 27 March 1998, in which the Council established a United Nations Mission in the Central African Republic (MINURCA) with effect from 15 April 1998 and welcomed the appointment of a Special Representative of the Secretary-General for the Central African Republic.

Following the usual consultations, I wish to inform you of my intention to appoint Mr. Oluyemi Adeniji (Nigeria) Special Representative of the Secretary-General for the Central African Republic and Head of MINURCA.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
