**Letter dated 9 November 2000 from the Secretary-General
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

As you know, we have for some time been providing support to the Arusha peace process on Burundi. Although the Peace Agreement was signed on 28 August 2000, a number of key issues still remain to be negotiated. A meeting is to be held in Arusha towards the end of this month, to resolve outstanding issues, and a donors' conference is planned for 11 and 12 December in Paris to garner support for the implementation of the agreement. I have therefore decided to extend the appointment of Mr. Ayite J. C. Kpakpo, Senior Adviser to the Facilitator, until 31 January 2001.

I should be grateful if you would bring this information to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
