Letter dated 22 March 2001 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP).

The Governments of Austria and Slovenia had informed me some time ago that they would be withdrawing their troops from UNFICYP by September 2001. Following the usual consultations, it is my intention to accept the offer of Slovakia to replace the Austrian and Slovenian troops.
