Letter dated 23 May 2002 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 307 (1971) of 21 December 1971, by which the Council decided that the United Nations Military Observer Group in India and Pakistan (UNMOGIP) should monitor the ceasefire line in Jammu and Kashmir. Since 1971, the ceasefire in Jammu and Kashmir has been monitored by some 45 military observers, who are presently contributed by Belgium, Chile, Denmark, Finland, Italy, the Republic of Korea, Sweden and Uruguay. The Government of Sweden has recently notified us that it intends to reduce its participation in UNMOGIP.

Having completed the necessary consultations, I propose that Croatia be added to the list of contributors to UNMOGIP.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
