I have the honour to inform you that your letter dated 25 June 2002 (S/2002/714) concerning Angola has been brought to the attention of the members of the Security Council.

They take note of the information contained in your letter and agree with your proposal to deploy up to 10 military liaison officers to Angola to support the implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding for the cessation of hostilities and the resolution of the outstanding military issues under the Lusaka Protocol (S/1994/1441, annex). They also look forward to receiving the report of the integrated assessment team dispatched to Angola and your recommendations to the Council with regard to the tasks and mandate of the United Nations presence in Angola.
