



## Security Council

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### Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

#### Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4791st meeting, held on 22 July 2003 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General pursuant to paragraph 24 of Security Council resolution 1483 (2003) (S/2003/715).

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Sergio Vieira de Mello, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Iraq.

In response to the request contained in a letter dated 17 July 2003 from the Permanent Representative of Spain to the United Nations (S/2003/750), the

President extended invitations under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Adnan Pachachi, Ahmad Chalabi and Aqeela al-Hashemi, members of the Governing Council of Iraq.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4792nd meeting, held on 23 July 2003 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Colombia, Indonesia, Israel, Italy, Japan, Nepal, Peru, the Republic of Korea, Uganda and Ukraine, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President, speaking in his capacity as Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism, briefed the Council in accordance with rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Côte d'Ivoire, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
