

Letter dated 12 April 2004 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to your letter of 8 April 2004 (S/2004/289), concurring with my proposal to appoint the Honourable Lord Bonomy as a permanent judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991. I have received a corresponding letter from the President of the General Assembly. Accordingly, I have appointed Lord Bonomy as a permanent judge of the International Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia, effective 1 June 2004, for the remainder of the term of office of Judge Richard May, which term will expire on 16 November 2005.
