谨提及《起诉应对 1994 年 1 月 1 日至 12 月 31 日期间在卢旺达境内的种族 灭绝和其他严重违反国际人道主义法行为负责者和应对这一期间邻国境内种族 灭绝和其他这类违法行为负责的卢旺达公民的国际刑事法庭规约》第 12(之二) 条第 2 款,其中规定:

"如遇根据本条选举或任命的分庭常设法官出缺,秘书长应与安全理事会主席和大会主席协商后,任命一名符合本规约第 12 条资格的法官接替,其任期为该出缺职位剩余的任期。"

我谨此通知你,圣基茨和尼维斯国民劳埃德·乔治·威廉斯法官将从 2004 年 3 月 31 日起辞去卢旺达问题国际法庭常设法官一职。

圣基茨和尼维斯政府已推举圣基茨和尼维斯国民查尔斯•迈克尔•丹尼斯•拜 伦爵士接替威廉斯法官。随信附上拜伦爵士的简历(见附件)。\*

我认为,拜伦爵士符合《卢旺达问题国际法庭规约》第 12 条规定的资格。 我还认为丹尼斯•拜伦爵士的任命有利于按照《规约》第 12 (之二) 条第 1 款(c) 项的规定,确保世界各大法系在该法庭均有足够的代表性。

因此,谨根据《卢旺达问题国际法庭规约》第12(之二)条第2款,与你协商任命丹尼斯•拜伦爵士一事。我期望获悉你对此事的意见。
