The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5128th meeting, held on 22 February 2005 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Kieran Prendergast, Under-Secretary-General for Political Affairs.

Children and armed conflict (*see* S/1998/44/Add.26; S/1999/25/Add.33; S/2000/40/Add.29 and 31; S/2001/15/Add.47; S/2002/30/Add.18; S/2003/40/Add.2 and 4; and S/2004/20/Add.3 and 16)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5129th meeting, held on 23 February 2005 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on children and armed conflict (S/2005/72). There was one suspension and one resumption of the meeting.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Canada, Gabon, Guinea, Iceland, India, Iraq, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Myanmar, Nigeria, Norway, Senegal, Sri Lanka and Uganda, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended invitations under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Olara Otunnu, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Children and Armed Conflict; Rima Salah, Deputy Executive Director of the United Nations Children's Fund; and Ibrahima Diouf, Special Adviser on Child Protection to the Executive Secretary of the Economic Community of West African States.

The meeting was suspended.

Upon the resumption of the meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Indonesia, Mali and the Niger, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/2005/8; to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2004-31 July 2005*).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Albania, Luxembourg and Serbia and Montenegro, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Søren Jessen-Petersen, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo.

Cross-border issues in West Africa (*see* S/2004/20/Add.12; *see also* S/2004/20/Add.5, 8, 10, 13, 17, 21, 22, 24, 31, 37, 44, 46, 50 and 51)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5131st meeting, held on 25 February 2005 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the progress report of the Secretary-General on ways to combat subregional and cross-border problems in West Africa (S/2005/86).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Burkina Faso, Côte d'Ivoire, Guinea, Luxembourg, Mali, the Niger, Nigeria and Sierra Leone, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended invitations under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Ahmedou Ould-Abdallah, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for West Africa and Head of the United Nations Office for West Africa, and Ibrahima Diouf, Special Adviser on Child Protection to the Executive Secretary of the Economic Community of West African States.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/2005/9; to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2004-31 July 2005*).
