Letter dated 10 May 2007 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1540 (2004) of 28 April 2004, concerning the non-proliferation of weapons of mass destruction. In paragraph 4 of the resolution, the Council established a Committee that would report to it on Member States' implementation of the resolution. In reporting to the Council, the Committee would, as appropriate, also call upon other expertise.

On 26 April 2007, the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1540 (2004) approved the recruitment of two new experts to fill existing vacancies in the current group of experts assisting the Committee in its work. Accordingly, I wish to inform you that I have appointed the following experts to facilitate the work of the Committee:

Brad Howlett (Australia)
